World Mission Sunday, celebrated this year on October 19-20, is a profound moment for Catholics worldwide to unite in prayer and actively support the Church's missionary work. The theme, "Go and invite everyone to the banquet" (Matthew 22:9), emphasizes the universal call of all baptized Christians to reach out and welcome everyone into a relationship with God. The Church, through her missionary activity, seeks to bring the message of salvation to all corners of the world, fulfilling Christ's command to "make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19).

Pope Francis has consistently reminded the faithful that mission work is not just something reserved for specific individuals or groups but is an ongoing commitment for all Christians. It involves sharing Christ's love, mercy, and communion in our everyday lives, from the neighborhoods we live in to the farthest corners of the globe. We are all called to be missionary disciples, whether through active service or by supporting the work of missionaries who bring Christ to distant lands.

World Mission Sunday also highlights the sacrifices made by missionaries who often work in challenging and remote environments. These men and women embody the Church's call to evangelize, sometimes at great personal cost. Through our prayers, active participation, and generous financial contributions, we support their efforts. Whether it is building schools, providing medical care, or offering spiritual support, missionaries rely on the prayers and aid of the universal Church to sustain their work.

El Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, celebrado este año los días 19 y 20 de octubre, es un momento profundo para que los católicos de todo el mundo se unan en oración y apoyen activamente la labor misionera de la Iglesia. El tema, "Vayan y llamen a todos al banquete" (Mateo 22:9), subraya el llamado universal de todos los cristianos bautizados a acercarse y dar la bienvenida a todos a una relación con Dios. La Iglesia, a través de su actividad misionera, busca llevar el mensaje de salvación a todos los rincones del mundo, cumpliendo con el mandato de Cristo de "hacer discípulos de todas las naciones" (Mateo 28:19).

El Papa Francisco ha recordado consistentemente a los fieles que el trabajo misionero no es algo reservado solo para individuos o grupos específicos, sino un compromiso continuo para todos los cristianos. Implica compartir el amor, la misericordia y la comunión de Cristo en nuestra vida cotidiana, desde los barrios donde vivimos hasta los lugares más lejanos del mundo. Todos estamos llamados a ser discípulos misioneros, ya sea a través del servicio activo o apoyando el trabajo de los misioneros que llevan a Cristo a tierras distantes.

El Domingo Mundial de las Misiones también destaca los sacrificios que hacen los misioneros, quienes a menudo trabajan en entornos desafiantes y remotos. Estos hombres y mujeres encarnan el llamado de la Iglesia a evangelizar, a veces a un gran costo personal. A través de nuestras oraciones, participación activa y generosas contribuciones financieras, apoyamos sus esfuerzos. Ya sea construyendo escuelas, proporcionando atención médica o brindando apoyo espiritual, los misioneros dependen de las oraciones y la ayuda de la Iglesia universal para sostener su trabajo.
